REPORTS FROM DEPARTMENT HEADS

Highway Superintendent Shawn Hayes was unable to attend the meeting and submitted his highway, water, and sewer department report to Supervisor Salisbury. On Behalf of Superintendent Hayes, Supervisor Salisbury discussed the highway report stating a 150-foot drainage pipe was installed to improve drainage at the end of Shepard Lane. The town's dirt roads have been graded and treated with calcium chloride. He also added that repair work will start on the Grant Hollow Bridge soon. Paving will start next week on Pinewoods Road, Mineral Springs Road and Hansen Road. The Water and Sewer report was also submitted, with nothing significant to report.

Chris Kelly, Town Historian, had prior engagements and also submitted her report to Supervisor Salisbury. Supervisor Salisbury reported that on Saturday, June 13th, Chris will attend Strawberry Fest at the Schaghticoke Fair grounds alongside the Schaghticoke Village historian Linda Bunk. She will display a poster highlighting the local soldiers

who served in the Revolutionary War. Supervisor Salisbury also noted that Chris attended the Hoosick History fair in Mid-May. While attendance wasn't large as last year, those who attended showed a strong interest.
